

QuickMarks



Thank you for your using QuickMarks.

1. Introduction

In a sense, QuickMarks is a reduced version of BookmarksX, another software product developed by MacHouse. QuickMarks allows the user to maintain and organize bookmarks easily. Whenever you drag and drop clipped text suggesting a URL onto the drop box, QuickMarks finds Google's PageRank for it.



2. Installing QuickMarks

You can give it its own folder if you like, or just drag and drop a copy of QuickMarks anywhere even inside a USB drive. And you are all set. If you have installed and used a beta/demo/trial version of QuickMarks, it is not necessary that you delete the application. If it's a time-limited version with the same application name, the full version will take over old data files.

3. Uninstalling QuickMarks

When launched for the first time, QuickMarks creates a folder containing several files inside the Application Support folder, which you need to trash on top of the application file itself.



4. Validating QuickMarks (not applicable to Mac App Store product)

In order to access all features that are available with QuickMarks, you need to validate your license at first. Please note that **you cannot use the trial version to validate your license.**

First of all, please run the licensed version of QuickMarks so that a file will be created inside the QuickMarks folder of the Application folder. Then click on the Preferences button on the top **Toolbar** menu and navigate to the tab labeled **License**. You must have received an e-mail message titled **QuickMarks License** from us by this time. In reference to **Validating a license**, please enter all input fields **except User login**. This field is not editable simply because it comes from your Mac. It must be the name of the current user that you reported earlier. The name of the current user is a username, not a system password, which should be kept confidential to yourself. We have generated a license signature based on your submission. If you submitted and therefore see a wrong user name, then you will not be able to validate your license. In such case, please contact us by opening a support ticket at MacHouse Support (<http://support.mhvt.net/>).

If all input fields are filled, then click on **Validate License** once and for all. If validation is successful, then a message should pop up, thanking you for your using QuickMarks.

5. Updating QuickMarks (not applicable to Mac App Store product)

None of our software products supports an automatic update feature for the security reason. QuickMarks is not an exception. In the meantime, find **Check Update** under the QuickMarks menu to see if there are newer versions available. You can also enable **Run update notification** in Preferences to let the application to do the job automatically every time you launch this application. If a message says there are, then choose **Download** to go to our website to download the latest version. You need to log in at first. Please refer to the e-mail message titled **QuickMarks License** for login information. After downloading the latest update, just replace an existing application file with a new one.
